An Act to provide for the continuance of the Eoglish language for the transaction of business in the Legislature of the State of Nagaland

Preamble.—WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the continuance of the English language for the transaction of business in the Legislature of the State of Nagaland;

It is hereby enacted in the Fifteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:---

Short title & commencement.—1. (1) This Act may be called the Nagaland State Legislature (Continuance of the English Language) Act, 1964.

(2) It shall come into force on the 26th day of January, 1965.

Continuance of the English language for the transaction of business in the Legislature of the State.—2. Notwithstanding the expiration of the period of fifteen years from the commencement of the Constitution, the English language may continue to be used for the transaction of business in the Legislature of the State of Nagaland.
